REGULATIONS made by the Minister responsible for Immigration in exercise of the powers conferred on hereby section 39(f) of the Immigration Act Chapter 156 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2011, as amended by Act No. 1 of 2014, Act No. 13 of 2016 and Act No. 46 of 2017, and all other powers thereunto her enabling.

**IMMIGRATION (DISEMBARKATION CARD)
REGULATIONS, 2019.**

2. – (1) Every person entering Belize (whether by air, land or sea) shall fill out and sign a disembarkation card in the form set out in the Schedule, if required to do so by the immigration officer on duty as stipulated by section 24 (4) of the Immigration Act.

(2) The disembarkation card may be integrated with, or appended to, the Customs Form C 200 made pursuant to the Customs (Declaration Form and Green Line Notice) Regulations, 1997, as amended, or any replacement form prescribed therefor.

3. The disembarkation card shall be set out in English and may also be set out in –

Languages on disembarkation card.

- (a) Spanish; or
- (b) English and Spanish; or
- (c) any other language as the Director of Border Management and Immigration Services may prescribe by Order,

and the distribution of the disembarkation card in any language shall be made in such manner as the Director of Immigration and Nationality Services may determine.

Under the Customs Laws of Belize, all persons leaving Belize are required to declare any currency in their possession in excess of \$20,000.00 BZD or foreign currency equivalent. If you are carrying currency in excess of \$20,000.00 BZD or foreign currency equivalent, you must complete a "Report of Currency Importation" Form C300, to be supplied by a Customs Officer. Only one Report of Currency Form per family is required and shall be completed by the head of the family.
